The Partner School of the Month for May is also a Gold Medalist and an Exceptional First Year Implementation for 2015. Congratulations to Taylor County Elementary School in Taylor, Florida. As of May 1, 85% of math students scoring lowest on the state test last year, gained one or more grade levels. Midyear testing showed 86% of fourth grade intervention students grew in their scale scores. And 83% of 5th students had an increase in their scale score.
