

Students can now view Assigned Objectives on their Student Progress Dashboard. Students can access their Dashboard by selecting the Progress icon on their home page. To view their Assigned Objectives have them choose the radio button next to Display Assigned Objectives. Completed objectives will provide the completion date, time on task, and the Post Assessment Score.

Congratulations to Sierra Elementary School in Truth or Consequences, NM our March Partner School of the Month!! Since the beginning of August, almost \(^3\)4 of their students have completed 1 or more levels in Ascend, with ¼ students completing 2 or more levels!!



"The 5th grade students of Sierra Elementary Complex have been working tenaciously to improve their math skills using the Ascend Math program during the 21/22 school year. The teachers have helped by providing as much positive support and feedback as possible. We constantly remind the students of how this program will help them identify and fill the gaps in their learning that have happened because of the Covid pandemic. We have found that giving the students a printed copy of the study guide and encouraging them to take notes from the video helps them tremendously. We also do small in-class celebrations when we hear a yodel because someone has successfully completed a unit, or whenever a student levels up. Students receive two certificates of completion (one for home and one to be displayed in the hallway) each time they level up and can also earn 500 tickets as part of our positive behavior rewards program. These tickets can be redeemed for prizes in our auctions. We have just begun implementation of another reward opportunity for the students also. Each student has a punch card and will receive a prize after getting 20 punches to complete the card. Each objective that is successfully completed results in one punch. "
