Teachers can easily track the number of objectives completed each week by accessing the Activity Completion Report. Let's all finish the school year strong!

Product Update

Flash Card Math reports are now available to view students' individual results. The report is a date ranged report and displays the student's most recent attempts during the date range selected, with a maximum of 10 attempts.

To access the Flash Card Math Student Report select Flash Card Math under the Reports tab. Next, select Flash Card Math Student Report. Create the report by selecting a Class, Student, and a date range. You can choose your own start and end date or select 7 days, 14 days or 30 days from the Time Frame dropdown menu. Select Create Report to view the report in a separate tab or select PDF Report to download the report.

Students can now view their Quiz results on their Student Progress Dashboard. Students can access their Dashboard by selecting the Progress icon on their home page. To view their Quiz results have them select the radio button next to Quizzes. Completed quizzes will provide the Quiz Name, Time on Task, the Date Completed, Status and their Score.

- 1. Select Certificates under the Reports tab.
- 2. Choose Individual or Batch Certificates.
