Product Updates

Teachers can now message students within Ascend Math. Select *Student Login*



Messages under the Reports tab. First, create the message you would like students to see upon their next login. Next, select Display Student Login Message. Choose the message from the dropdown menu. You also have the option to choose a start and end date for your message. Once the message has been selected, choose one of your classes to display your message to. You can display the message to all students in the class, a select group, or an individual. Don't forget to click Save!

The Attempts column on the Live Student Tracker can now be hidden. This is helpful for teachers who display their Live Student Tracker on a white board for all students to see. Don't forget the Level column can also be hidden.
