Tip of the Month

The Live Student Tracker indicates which students are working in assigned objectives. A "†" will appear next to the student's name if they are working in an assigned objective instead of their automated study plan.

The Live Student Tracker also has color-coded icons under the Attempts column. A green thumbs up lets you know the student has attempted the post assessment once or twice. A yellow hand indicates three to five post assessment attempts. A red hand means your student has attempted the post assessment more than six times unsuccessfully and is need of intervention.

If an objective is not mastered after three attempts, students will receive a hand on their home page map with a mouseover message "See your teacher for help with this objective".

Product Update

In addition to Pre and Post Assessment results, the Activity Completion Report now includes the number of assigned objectives each student has completed during the report time frame. Access the Activity Completion Report under the Reports tab to track how many objectives your students complete daily, weekly or any time frame of your choice.
