Product Updates

Students can now view their Assigned Objectives on their Student Progress Dashboard. Students can access their Dashboard by selecting the Progress icon on their home page. To view their Assigned Objectives have them select the radio button next to Display Assigned Objectives. Completed objectives will provide the completion date, time on task and the Post Assessment Score. Quiz results will be available on the Student Progress Dashboard next week.

The Total Hours Worked Report and Level Completion Report can now be run using a custom start and end date.

Tip of the Month

Remind your students after 5 minutes of inactivity, Ascend Math will log them out of their account. After 4 minutes they will receive a notification and can click Continue to stay logged into their account. This feature helps you keep track of the time your students have worked each day.
