

Partner School of the Month

Congratulations to Oneida Elementary School in Oneida, TN, our partner school of the month. Since January, active students

have averaged 1 hour 20 min. a week in Ascend.

In the past three months, 30% have already gained at least one grade level. Their average gain in score in Ascend Math is 14%, with some students gaining as much as 63%.

Oneida Elementary was also the first school to be nominated for the 2015 Gold Medal.
