They adopted Ascend Math as a Tier 2 intervention to help fill in gaps that were shown on state testing. The majority of their students far surpassed their target scores half way through the year!

Answer to Math Puzzler



Boy A had 10 eggs. Boy B had 30 eggs. Boy C had 50 eggs. To end up with the same amount of money, each boy sold 7 eggs for 5 cents, then sold the remaining individual eggs for 15 cents each -- so each boy earned 50 cents. (Multiple solutions to the problem are likely.)
