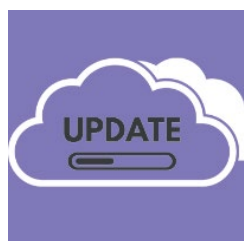
We are proud to recognize Sierra Elementary as our May Partner School of the Month for 2023! – Truth or Consequences – New Mexico

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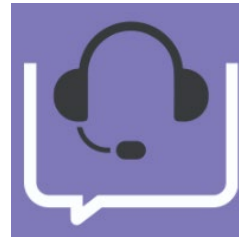
## 6 Things You Need to Know
